



2024 M-Engin Academy Participant Agreement (to be submitted once admitted to the program)

The M-Engin Academy is designed to maximize your academic, personal, and professional success at the University of Michigan. The staff of the M-Engin Academy will partner with you to help you achieve your goals and provide programs and services for you so that you will be able to fully experience the scope, scholarship, and scale of the University.

In order to receive the most benefit as an M-Engin Academy participant, you will be required to fulfill certain program obligations during your first two years as a College of Engineering student. Your full participation in all of the requirements will earn you \$3000; \$1500 paid at the completion of the summer program, \$750 paid at the end of Fall Term 2024, and \$750 paid at the end of Winter Term 2025. In addition, we will assist you in gaining either a corporate internship, a paid research opportunity, or employment with the M-Engin Academy Summer Program during the Summer of 2025.

To accept our offer of admission to the M-Engin Academy and confirm your understanding of the program obligations, we ask that you read and sign the following agreement.

I recognize that as an M-Engin Academy participant, I will be required to fulfill the following obligations:

- I will attend the M-Engin Summer Transition Program in its entirety from June 23 July 27. I will adhere to the guidelines of the summer program as outlined in the M-Engin Academy Summer Transition Program Handbook. These include:
 - Participants must remain within campus boundaries, as designated by program staff, for the duration of the program.
 - Participants are not allowed to have a motor vehicle or bicycle on campus during the Summer Transition Program.
 - o Participants must attend all classes and scheduled activities of the Summer Transition Program.
 - o Participants must be in their residence hall rooms by 12 am nightly.
 - Participants must adhere to all guidelines of conduct within the residence hall and during program activities.
- I will reside in Bursley Residence Hall during my first year.
- I will attend all required M-Engin Group meetings during the first two years.
- I will follow course scheduling recommendations that I agree to in consultation with my academic advisor and M-Engin Academic Coach
- I will work closely with M-Engin Academy staff as I plan extra-curricular or part-time employment activities during the academic year.
- I will not pledge to a social fraternity or sorority during my first year.
- I will abide by all University policies (e.g. policies regarding use of illegal drugs, alcohol, etc.).
- I will participate in designated academic support activities during the first year, including regularly scheduled Math Supplemental Instruction sessions and Science Learning Center Chemistry study groups.
- I will attend all designated personal and professional development activities during the first year.
- I will meet with my M-Engin Academic Coach monthly during the academic year to discuss academic progress and personal and professional goals.
- I will commit my best effort to all M-Engin Academy activities.
- I will strive to maintain the integrity and standards of the M-Engin Academy.
- I will contribute my individual skills and strengths to the overall success of the M-Engin Academy community.

Academic Expectations

As an M-Engin Academy participant, I understand I must maintain a term and cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 to remain in good standing with the program. Receiving lower than a 3.0 GPA will result in probation. To assist probation students in the transition to the required 3.0 GPA, there will be more frequent sessions with the academic coach, and students will follow additional prescribed actions to ensure academic progress.

I acknowledge that I am signing up for the M-Engin Academy in good faith, and that I will make an honest effort to meet the obligations outlined above. I understand that not meeting the obligations can result in a review by M-Engin Academy staff regarding possible reduction or loss of the M-Engin stipend and/or possible dismissal from the program.
